

## Glucagon receptor family in GtoPdb v.2021.3

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### Abstract

The glucagon family of receptors (**nomenclature as agreed by the NC-IUPHAR Subcommittee on the Glucagon receptor family [162]**) are activated by the endogenous peptide (27-44 aa) hormones [glucagon](#), [glucagon-like peptide 1](#), [glucagon-like peptide 2](#), glucose-dependent insulinotropic polypeptide (also known as [gastric inhibitory polypeptide](#)), [GHRH](#) and [secretin](#). One common precursor (*GCG*) generates [glucagon](#), [glucagon-like peptide 1](#) and [glucagon-like peptide 2](#) peptides [119].
