#### Pros:


- Associated with each contributor

- Cannot add multiple roles
- Not displayed on
  Edinburgh Research
  Explorer



#### **Recording CRediT in Pure**

#### Pros:

- Can add multiple roles to each associated contributor
- Can be recorded at different publication stages, e.g. submission, acceptance, publication
- Can be added/edited by contributors themselves
- Can be added retrospectively

#### Cons:

- Not automated cannot be imported
- Not reportable
- Not displayed on Edinburgh Research Explorer



#### **Next steps**

- Approval from University Pure User Group
- Guidance and training for users
- Request improvement from Elsevier
  Importable, reportable, displayed on Edinburgh Research Explorer
- Monitor development from Elsevier
