

3C. 3-Ketosteroid receptors (version 2019.4) in the IUPHAR/BPS Guide to Pharmacology Database

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Abstract

Steroid hormone receptors (**nomenclature as agreed by the NC-IUPHAR Subcommittee on Nuclear Hormone Receptors [65, 193]**) are nuclear hormone receptors of the NR3 class, with endogenous agonists that may be divided into 3-hydroxysteroids (**estrone** and **17 β -estradiol**) and 3-ketosteroids (**dihydrotestosterone** [DHT], **aldosterone**, **cortisol**, **corticosterone**, **progesterone** and **testosterone**).
