

3C. 3-Ketosteroid receptors in GtoPdb v.2021.3

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Abstract

Steroid hormone receptors (**nomenclature as agreed by the NC-IUPHAR Subcommittee on Nuclear Hormone Receptors [74, 215, 3]**) are nuclear hormone receptors of the NR3 class, with endogenous agonists that may be divided into 3-hydroxysteroids ([estrone](#) and [17 \$\beta\$ -estradiol](#)) and 3-ketosteroids ([dihydrotestosterone](#) [DHT], [aldosterone](#), [cortisol](#), [corticosterone](#), [progesterone](#) and [testosterone](#)). For rodent GR and MR, the physiological ligand is corticosterone rather than cortisol.
