

## Neuropeptide S receptor in GtoPdb v.2023.1

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### Abstract

The neuropeptide S receptor (NPS receptor) responds to the 20 amino-acid peptide neuropeptide S derived from a precursor (*NPS*, *POCOP6*). NPS activates its receptor at low nanomolar concentrations elevating intracellular cAMP and calcium levels [71]. Currently, some peptidic and small molecule NPS receptor antagonists are available as research tools [27, 79, 8, 59]. No NPS receptor ligands are currently used clinically.
